REQUIREMENTS

Lewes Public Library Summer Youth Ambassadors will be treated as young professionals, and will receive training that will help to prepare them for their futures in both school and work. As Youth Ambassadors they will be required to:

- Attend three 2-hour training sessions on May 20 (4:00 6:00), June 3 (4:00 6:00), and June 10 (4:00 6:00).
- Serve a 2-hour shift each week at the library for 8 weeks, between June 14th and August 6th. The Library will do everything it can to accommodate schedules, but once a shift is assigned, the Ambassador is required to serve that shift, or find another Ambassador to serve it for them.
- Communicate in a timely manner with the Ambassador Coordinators should they be unable to attend a shift due to illness. Failure to show up for a shift, or failure to communicate regarding inability to attend due to illness, will result in a warning and docking service hours on the 1st offense, and may result in removal from the program thereafter. Summer Youth Ambassadors will be expected to conduct themselves as young professionals, and be responsible for:
- Showing up for all 3 training sessions.
- Showing up to all their shifts, or for finding a substitute for their shift from the pool of other Summer Youth Ambassadors.
- Dressing appropriately to work in the library, which means no cut-off shorts, bare midriffs or bare shoulders.
- Conducting themselves in a professional manner, which means applying themselves to tasks diligently, following instructions, and keeping all electronic devices put away during their shift.

Summer Youth Ambassadors will receive Community Service Hours for their service in the program, and recognition from the Library as a graduate of the program.
