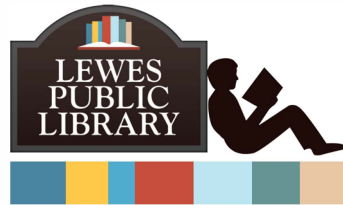

Why Does the Library Need Support?


Our new Library opened in June 2016. Since then, visitors to the Library have grown to over 15,000 per month. We see this trend continuing for years to come due to the growth of our area. By 2030, for example, it is forecasted 12,700 new people will move to our Library service area, in addition to 7,000 new owners of second homes.

This level of growth means added costs of staffing, supplies, and maintenance of our new building. To meet those costs we must rely on the generosity of our community.

Society Members are all those who have remembered the Library in their wills as well as all those who have made significant lifetime donations of \$25,000 or more.

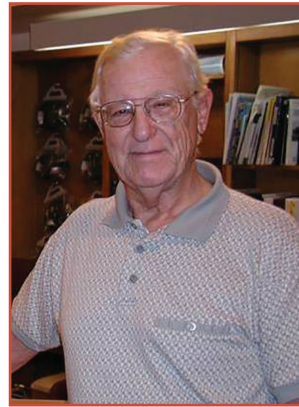
We recognize these very important donors in a variety of ongoing ways:

Lewes Public Library Endowment Fund

An Endowment is a long term, permanent fund that provides income each year. A gift to this fund can be a lasting expression of your appreciation for the Library. The Library Board will allocate the annual income for the enhancement of library services forever and will respect the wishes of each donor.





Gifts to this fund are restricted to provide for long term capital maintenance and improvements needs for the new, 2016 building the Library built and owns on Adams Avenue.

Special Designations

For gifts over \$25,000, and in consultation with Library staff, donors may specify how they wish their gift to be applied – for example, for the Children’s Wing or to support programs and classes.
