TAB Constitution

- ★ Review of the TAB Constitution progress; Article III, Membership, discussed
- ★ Member cap determined to be 12 members ; To be an official board member, one must have an accepted application, attend at least 9 meetings and have 3 service hours for TAB a year
- ★ Non members always welcome to attend meetings, but will not be able to participate in voting; Can gain 1 hour of community service for attending
- ★ Meetings will be member and officer lead, with team delegation for special circumstances concerning applications; applicants need to sit in on one meeting as a non member before application is reviewed
- ★ Board unanimously voted to cap member age from 13 18
- ★ Article topics and content will be discussed at meetings, with the duty of writing passed onto member(s) each month; Ella and Ava to write article concerning member and officer roles to be shared next meeting

Big Book of Information

- \star Soon, Emily will launch the creation of the Big Book of Information
- ★ This book will be a centralized place to house a variety of information and resources for teens and parents; Information will range from college search assistance to planned parenthood outreach
- ★ Emily is seeking the assistance of TAB members in the creation of the book; volunteers would need to research, write and vehemently vet and cite their sources concerning their topic of choice
